Submit your completed application and liability waiver and fee to the Student Recreation Center Reception Desk.

W&M RETIREE

Persons who have worked for the state of Virginia for 10 years or more and were employed by the William and Mary at the time of retirement are eligible for a Privilege Card.

STAFF MEMBERS OF: ARAMARK at WILLIAM AND MARY, WILLIAM AND MARY~BARNES & NOBLE BOOKSTORE & THE W&M CHILD CARE CENTER

Staff members of these companies who are in a management position or who have been employed by the company for 5 years or more are eligible to purchase a Privilege Card under the W&M Part-Time Staff rate. A letter must accompany application stating eligibility. The letter must be on company letterhead and signed by your supervisor. Staff members who are not in a management position or have not been employed by the company for 5 years or more are eligible to purchase a Privilege Card under the Non-College Affiliate rate.

William and Mary Campus Recreation

GUEST POLICIES

- Any student, faculty or staff member with a valid William and Mary ID, may bring up to two guests per visit into the recreational facilities. This applies to regularly scheduled informal recreational periods, not intramural or sport club activities. Guest passes are available for daily or weekly use only and may be purchased at the Bee McLeod Recreation Center Reception Desk during open hours.
- 2. Privilege Card holders may bring one guest per visit.
- 3. Visiting alumni may purchase a dally guest pass. Alumni must show a pictured ID when purchasing a guest pass and provide their graduation year. A sponsor is not required.
- 4. Guests (like all participants) must be 18 years of age or older.
- 5. Guests must show a photo ID when purchasing a guest pass.
- Guests must carry their guest pass with them at all times while in the Bee McLeod Recreation Center except when using pass to check out equipment.
- 7. All guests are subject to the same policies and regulations as the entire campus community. Violation of these policies is cause for revocation of privileges and removal from the facilities.
- 8. Guests may rent a locker and lock for the day at no charge.
- 9. Sponsors must accompany their guests at all times.

NOTE: A guest is someone who is known by you and who knows you. It is a violation of guest policies to sponsor anyone for the sole purpose of their gaining access/entrance into a college facility.
